ALS Action Canada is a patient-led, volunteer-driven registered charity working to improve access to ALS therapies, advocate for increased research funding, and advance policy change.

To support research and accelerate impact, ALS Action Canada leads the ALS Super Fund, a designated charitable fund that advances ALS research and related initiatives. Donations to the ALS Super Fund are administered by Charitable Impact, providing a streamlined and transparent giving experience.

Community fundraising events support ALS Action Canada's mission and grant-making initiatives, with many donations directed through the ALS Super Fund as our primary charitable giving vehicle.

Community fundraising plays an important role in strengthening this patient-driven voice and advancing meaningful change in the fight against ALS.

- Walks, runs, or fitness challenges
- Golf tournaments or sporting events
- Dinners, galas, or social gatherings

- Community events, concerts, or school activities

1 Share Your Event Details Early

Sharing these details helps us acknowledge your event accurately and ensures clarity for your donors, sponsors, and participants.

2 Clarify Roles

As the event organizer, you have the flexibility to design and run an event that reflects your interests, community, and creativity.

Event materials should describe the event as “benefiting the ALS Super Fund, led by ALS Action Canada.”

ALS Action Canada should not be implied as the host or organizer.

3 Using ALS Action Canada or ALS Super Fund's Name & Logo

To ensure our patient-led voice and visual identity are represented accurately and consistently, please let us know:

- How the name and/or logo will be used
- Where it will appear (e.g., social media, posters, banners, websites, merchandise)
- The purpose of the materials (promotion, recognition, etc.)

Important Guidelines:

- ✗ The logo may not be altered, distorted, or combined with other logos without prior approval
- ✓ Use of the logo on collateral or merchandise requires advance approval and a mock-up for review
- ✗ ALS Super Fund or Action Canada should not be listed as a sponsor, partner, or event host unless explicitly agreed in writing.

Once the details are shared, we'll provide approved logo files and simple usage guidelines.

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Collect & Send Donations

There are two ways your event can support our mission:

Option 1: ALS Super Fund (via Charitable Impact – Recommended)

- Secure online donations
- Automatic tax receipts issued by Charitable Impact
- Simple tracking of funds raised

We can guide you through setting up a Giving Group through Charitable Impact to support the ALS Super Fund.

If submitting a cheque to support the ALS Super Fund, it must be made payable according to Charitable Impact’s specific instructions (we will provide these details once your event is confirmed).

Option 2: ALS Action Canada (Direct Donation)

As a registered charity, ALS Action Canada can issue official tax receipts for eligible donations. For cash donations of \$20 or more requiring a tax receipt, the event organizer must provide:

- Donor full name
- Mailing address
- Donation amount

This information must accompany the submitted funds in order for a charitable tax receipt to be issued. All event proceeds should be submitted within 30 days of the event and include the event name for reference.

IMPORTANT: YEAR-END TAX RECEIPT TIMING

To be eligible for a charitable tax receipt within a given calendar year, all donations must be received by **December 31** of that year.



Cheques must be delivered and dated on or before **December 31**



Late submissions will be accepted in the following tax year



We recommend submitting funds as early as possible, especially for year-end events

Important Note

While we are grateful for your support, ALS Action Canada cannot assume responsibility for any expenses, financial losses, damages, or liabilities related to your event. All planning costs, contractual obligations, and financial risks remain with the event organizer.

If you have questions about timing or submission, please contact us in advance to ensure eligibility.

A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

As the event organizer, you may wish to consider:

- Venue arrangements and permissions
- Any permits, insurance, or local approvals required
- Managing event expenses and staying within your budget
- Guest safety, accessibility, and comfort
- Food or beverage licenses and considerations (if applicable)
- Age restrictions or audience suitability
- Equipment or audiovisual needs (microphones, projectors, etc.)
- Volunteer or staff support for the day of the event
- Marketing and communication with participants
- Timing for collecting and submitting donations (within 30 days)
- Any local regulations regarding fundraising, raffles, or games of chance
